read for their school, too!*

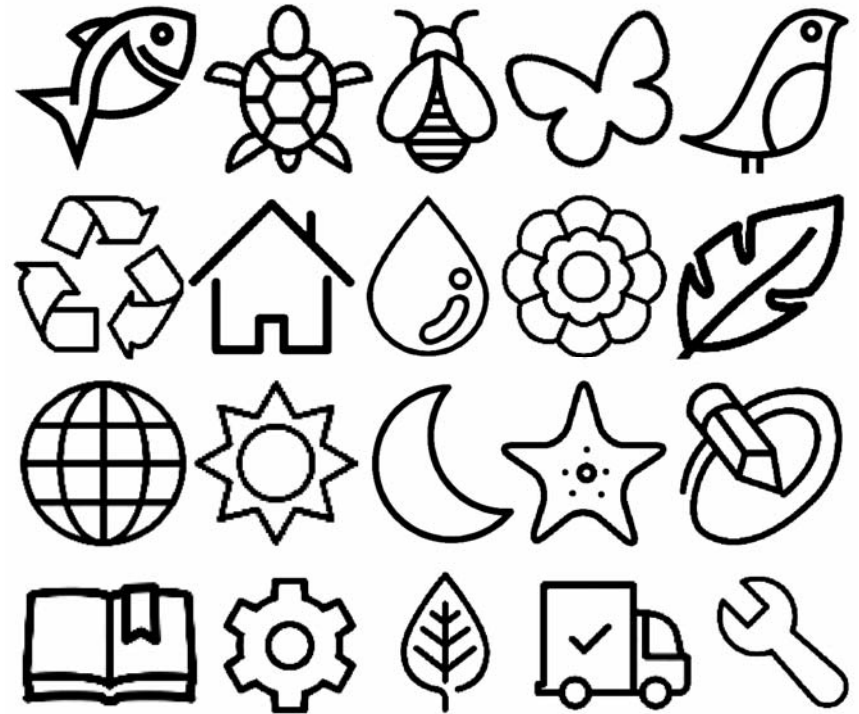


READING TIMELINE:

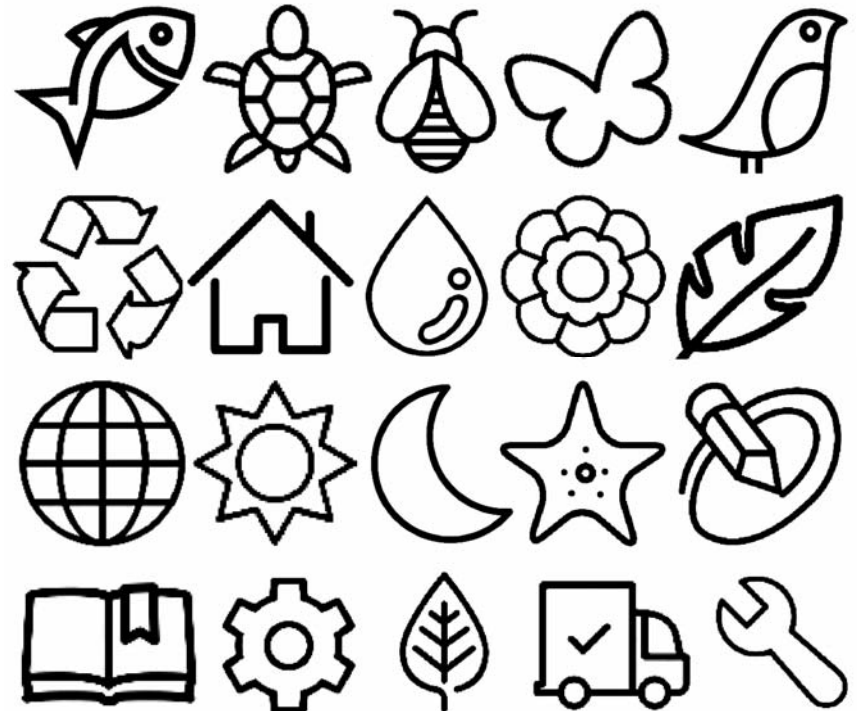
June 1 - You can start

Bring one of your stuffed animals to spend an overnight at the library.

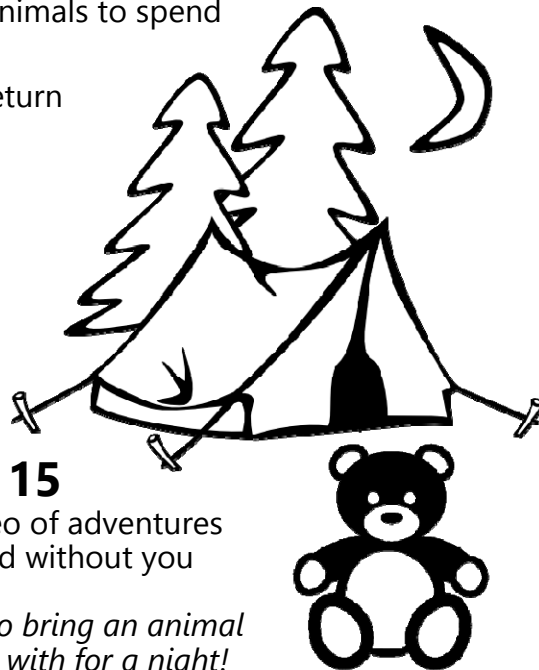
We promise your pal will return full of stories about their overnight adventure!

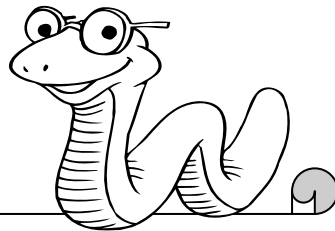


The library will be taking registrations for the summer library program, and there's always fresh, local produce and crafts.
